

**MUNICIPALITY OF PEMBINA**

**BY-LAW NO. 2026-02**

**A By-law of the Municipality of Pembina to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Community of Manitou.**

**WHEREAS** a municipality has the direction, control and management of municipal roads within its boundaries;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 90(1) of the Highway Traffic Act provides for a traffic authority to make rules or by-laws to regulate and control vehicular and other traffic and the parking thereof within its jurisdiction;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Municipality of Pembina enacts as follows:

1. THAT no person shall park or leave any vehicle standing on the West side of Jukes Street between Front Avenue and Souris Avenue between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.; Monday through Friday;
2. THAT no person shall park or leave any vehicle standing on the West side of Mary Street between Front Avenue and Souris Avenue between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.; Monday through Friday;
3. That no person shall park or leave any vehicle standing at the following locations in Manitou:
  - a. North side of Fuller Avenue, from the back lane to approximately 15.25 metres down Fuller Avenue towards Hamilton Street;
  - b. West side of Carrie Street between intersections of Dufferin Avenue/Carrie Street and Ellis Avenue/Carrie Street from 8:00 a.m to 6:00 p.m., Monday – Friday;
4. That By-Laws 4/2013, 2/2011, 6/98, 13/95 are hereby rescinded.
